INCOME TAX ID THEFT

Chesterfield County Police Department, Crime Prevention Unit (804) 318 - 8699

Tax-related identity theft occurs when someone uses your stolen Social Security number to file a tax return claiming a fraudulent refund. You may be unaware that this has happened until you efile your return and discover that a return already has been filed using your SSN. Or, the IRS may send you a letter saying we have identified a suspicious return using your SSN. If you have become a victim of income tax ID theft the Chesterfield County Police Department recommends you do the following:

- Report the incident to the IRS: (800) 908-4490.
 - Complete IRS Form 14039, the Identity Theft Affidavit (A Google search will find the form)
- Report the incident to the Virginia Department of Taxation for Identity Theft (804) 404-4185.
- File a complaint online with the Federal Trade Commission at https://identitytheft.gov/
- Contact one of the three major credit bureaus and file a fraud alert. The one you select will contact the other two for you
 - o Equifax www.equifax.com or (800)766-0008
 - o Experian www.experian.com or (888) 397-3742
 - o TransUnion www.transunion.com or (800) 680-7289
- Consider a private identity theft protection service
- Contact your financial institutions and discuss your situation. Close or change any accounts you feel may be threatened.
- Monitor your credit reports at www.annualcreditreport.com
